BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Drusilla, Daughter of Herod Agrippa 1st

The chief other source of information regarding *Drusilla* is <u>Josephus' History</u>. *Drusilla* was the <u>Youngest of the Three Daughters</u> of <u>Herod Agrippa I</u>, <u>Her Sisters</u> being the oldest, <u>Bernice</u> and the middle child, <u>Mariamne</u>. <u>Herod Agrippa I</u> also had One Heir and Son, <u>Herod Agrippa</u> II.

Drusilla was born about 38 A.D. and was married at the age of 14 in 52 A.D. to Azizus, Priest / King of Emeza (Arabic Kingdom of Southeastern Modern Day Turkey & Syria). Shortly afterward, about 1 year later, Drusilla <u>Was Seduced</u> to desert her husband by Marcus Antonius Felix Who, Who employed a Cyprian Sorcerer, Simon (Magnus), to Carry Out His Seductive Purposes. Drusilla was also influenced to take this step by the <u>Cruelty & Abuse</u> of her Husband Azizus and the Hatred of Her Sister, Bernice, Who was always jealous of Drusilla's Beauty.

In fact, *Bernice Who* helped make the arrangements to marry off *Drusilla* to *Azizus* in the first place, as a long-standing tension had existed between the *Kingdom of Emeza* & the Line of *Idumean Kings* of Her Father's Lineage. This marriage was supposed to ease tensions between the *Two Roman Vassal Kingdoms*.

<u>Her Marriage</u> to Felix took place in 54 A.D. and She had one Son, Agrippa III, Who perished at the age of 23, under the Rule of Emperor Titus in the <u>Eruption of Mt. Vesuvius</u> in 79 A.D.
