Elizabeth – Unfertile & Barren Womb

- 1) “But they had no child.” v 7a
- 2) “Because Elizabeth was barren, & they were both well advanced in years. v 7b
- 3) “And Zacharias said to the angel, “How shall I know this? For I am an old man, & my wife is well advanced in years!” v 18

Zacharias’ Visitation - Luke 1:11-20

“He was troubled” v 12

“The angel said to him” v 13

“Do not be afraid, Zacharias” v 13

“Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son” v 13

“And you shall call his name John” v 13

“For he will be great in the sight of the Lord, & shall drink neither wine nor strong drink. He will also be filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother’s womb. And he will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God. He will also go before Him in The power & spirit of Elijah, ‘to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,’ & the disobedient to the wisdom of just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord!” vs. 15-17

And Zacharias said to the angel, “How shall I know this? For I am an old man, & my wife is well advanced in years!” v 18

Gabriel’s Announcement - Luke 1:11-20

Zacharias

“And the angel answered & said to him” v 19

“I am Gabriel, who stands in the presence of presence of God, & I was sent to speak to you & bring you these glad tidings!” v 19

Mary - Virginity & No Union With A Man

- 1) “To a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David.” v 27a
- 2) “The virgin’s name was Mary.” v 27b
- 3) “Then Mary said to the angel, “How can this be, since I do not know a man?” v 34

Mary’s Visitation Luke 1:28-38

“She was troubled” v 28

“The angel said to her” v 30

“Do not be afraid, Mary” v 30

“You will conceive in your womb & bring forth a Son” v 31

“And shall call His name Jesus” v 31

“He will be great, & will be called the Son of the Highest; & the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, & of His Kingdom there will be no end.” ... “The Holy Spirit will come upon you, & the power of the Highest will overshadow; therefore, also, that the Holy One who is to be born born will be called the Son of God!” vs. 32-33 & 35b

Then Mary said to the angel, “How can this be, since I do not know a man?” v 34

Gabriel’s Announcement - Luke 1:28-38

Mary

“And the angel answered & said to her” v 35

“Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin’s name was Mary. And having come in, the angel said to her, “Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!” vs. 26-28

Gabriel’s Announcement - Luke 1:11-20

Zacharias

“But behold, you will be mute & not able to speak until the day these things take place, because you did not believe my words which will be fulfilled in their own time!” v 20

Gabriel’s Announcement - Luke 1:28-38

Mary

“Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; & this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren. For with God nothing will be impossible!” Then Mary said, “Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word.” vs. 36-38
