(In The Year 34 A.D.)¹ Ananias went his way and entered the house; and <u>laying his hands on him</u> (Saul), he (Ananias) Said (Rhema), "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, Who Appeared to you on the road as you came, (He) <u>has sent me</u> that you <u>may receive</u> Your Sight and <u>be filled</u> with the Holy Spirit!" Immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and <u>he received</u> His Sight (Healing of Physical Sight & Transformation by Divine Sight) at once; and he <u>arose</u> and (he) <u>was baptized</u>. So, when he had received food, he was strengthened. Then Saul spent some days with the Disciples at Damascus.¹ Acts 9:17-19 (NKJV)

A1: King Aretas (IV) Helped The Jewish Authorities Because Of His Official Responsibilities As Governor Of Northern Palestine & Syria Under Roman Rule

A2: King Aretas Helped The Jews Because He Also Personally Wanted Saul/Paul Killed!

a) This Would Imply That Saul/Paul Had Openly Evangelized To The Nabataean People!

b) Therefore, He Had Previously Upset The Local Religious

& Government Authorities In His Exile During Those 3 Years!

FACT

In Any Case, Saul/Paul Was Now A Hunted Man With A Price On His Head! Q: "So, What Is The Real Root Cause For Hunting Down Saul/Paul By Both Of These Groups? A: Because Of What He Debated, Preached, Proved, Taught, & Testified To:

Acts 9:22 Q: "Where Have We Encountered A Young Man That Also Was Able To Testify With Power & Confound All His Jewish Brothers & Contemporaries?" A: Stephen the Martyr!

And Stephen, Full Of Faith and Power, did Great Wonders and Signs among the people.
