And finding Disciples, We (The Eight) stayed There (Tyre) Seven Days. They (Disciples at Tyre) told Paul through the *Spirit* not to go up to Jerusalem. When We had come to the end of those days, We (The Eight) departed and went on our way; and They (All the Disciples at Tyre) accompanied Us, with Their Wives and Children, till We were out of the City (of Tyre). And We (All Together) knelt down on the shore and prayed. When We (All Together) had taken our leave of one another, We (The Eight) boarded the ship, & They (Disciples at Tyre) returned home. And when We (The Eight) had finished our voyage from Tyre, We came to Ptolemais, greeted the Brethren (of Ptolemais), and stayed with Them one day.

Started During the Dispersion of the Church After The Martyrdom of Stephen.
Possibly Started By Peter Or Philip The Evangelist,

One of the Original #7 Deacons of the Church in Jerusalem

Past Story - Spring 32 A.D.

Now <u>Those Who Were Scattered after the Persecution that Arose Over Stephen</u> traveled as far as <u>Phoenicia</u> (Tyre & Sidon), <u>Cyprus</u>, and <u>Antioch</u> (On The Orontes), <u>Preaching the Word</u> to no one but the <u>Jews only</u> ...

Past Story – Fall 46 A.D.

... But some of them were men from Cyprus and Cyrene, who, when they had come to Antioch, spoke to the Hellenists, Preaching the Lord Jesus. And the *Hand of the Lord* was with them, and a great number believed and turned to the *Lord*. Then news of these things came to the ears of the Church in Jerusalem, and They (Elders & Church Leaders) sent out Barnabas to go as far as Antioch.

Future Story – Late Winter / Early Spring 57 A.D.

On the next day We Who were Paul's Companions (The Eight: Paul ¹, Sopater ² of Berea, Aristarchus, ³ & Secundus of the Thessalonians, ⁴ Gaius of Derbe, ⁵ Timothy, ⁶ Tychicus ⁷ & Trophimus of Asia. ⁸) departed and came to Caesarea, and entered the *House of Philip the Evangelist*, Who was One of the Seven (First Deacons of the Church in Jerusalem) and stayed with Him. Now this Man had Four Virgin Daughters Who *Prophesied*. And We stayed many days.

1) Edification, 2) Exhortation, 3) Strengthen, 4) Preach, & 5) Teach

These Follow-Up Visits Includes: <u>Public Preaching, Teaching, Testimonies, & Miracles</u>, Which In Turn Provide New Decisions & Believers To Add To The Local Church Community CA3

These Follow-Up Visits Always Include: Paul's Follow Up 4-Part Plan

1) Report / Testify, 2) Encourage / Decision 3) Commission / Ordain, & 4) Equip / Mentor
1) Report / Testify

Report the Advancement of the Kingdom in the Other Churches: The Number of New Believers, The Number & Names of New Church Elders & Leaders, Testify to the Miracles: Signs & Wonders God Has Performed, & The Faith of Those Who Have Faced Tribulation, Imprisonment, Beatings, & Martyrdom for the Name of Jesus Christ Our Lord. This in Turn Edifies & Strengthens the Local Church.

2) Encourage / Decision

Encourage the Hearts & Minds of Believers By Demonstrating that God Is Faithful to the Other Churches & Listening to the Stories of the Local Church. Seeking New Decisions of Faith By Both Justification & Sanctification of the Local Believers & Neighbors. This Edifies & Strengthens the Local Church. It Also Exhorts the Church to Go Onto Higher Ground Growing in the Faith & in Holiness of Heart, Mind, & Life. This Also Brings New Preaching, Teaching, Testimonies, & Miracles In Public Services.

3) Commission / Ordain

This Divine Laying On Of Hands & Invoking the Coming of the Holy Spirit Brings New Strength & Edification Through the Commission & Ordination of New Church Elders: Priests, Pastors, Deacons, Missionaries, & Teachers. This in Turns Increases Exhortation, Preaching, & Teaching in the Local Church.

4) Equip / Mentor

Equipping & Mentoring New Believers & Existing Christians Together in the Gifts & Fruits of the Holy Spirit, Bible Study, etc. Provides New: Edification, Exhortation, Strength, Preaching, Teaching, Leadership, & Service in the Local Church & Community. This In Turn Increases the Local Evangelism Efforts & Outreach of the Local Church into the Community.
