And behold (in Lystra), a certain Disciple was there, named Timothy, the Son of a Certain Jewish Woman Who Believed (In Christ), but His Father was Greek (Pagan – Unbeliever). He (Timothy) was well spoken of by the Brethren Who were at Lystra and Iconium. Paul wanted to have Him (Timothy) go on with Him. And He (Paul) took Him (Timothy) and Circumcised Him because of the Jews ('Judiazers') Who were in that Region, for They all knew that His Father was Greek (Pagan – Unbeliever). And as They (Paul, Silas, & Timothy) went through the Cities (From the 1st Missionary Journey), They delivered to Them (Disciples) the Decrees to Keep (Official Church Encyclical), which were determined by the Apostles and Elders (of the Church) at Jerusalem. So, the Churches (in Asia Minor) were Strengthened in the Faith, and Increased in Number daily.

Paul, an Apostle of Jesus Christ by the Will of God, according to the Promise of Life, which is in Christ Jesus, To Timothy, a Beloved Son ...

Paul Continues, "This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good warfare, having faith and a good conscience ...

Paul Writes, "Let no one despise your youth (Timothy), but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity" ...

Paul Concludes, "But You, O Man of God (Timothy), flee these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness. Fight the Good Fight of Faith, Lay Hold on Eternal Life, to which you were also called and have Confessed the Good Confession in the Presence of Many Witnesses. I urge you in the Sight of God Who gives Life to all things, and before Christ Jesus Who Witnessed the Good Confession before Pontius Pilate, that You keep this Commandment without spot, blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ's Appearing. Guard what was committed to Your Trust, avoiding the profane and idle babblings and contradictions of what is falsely called knowledge, by professing it some have strayed concerning the Faith. Be Ready in Season and out of Season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. Official Church Stance On Circumcision

"The Apostles, Elders, and the Brethren, To the Brethren Who are of the Gentiles in Antioch, Syria, and Cilicia: Greetings: Since We (Whole Church Council) have heard that Some Who Went Out from Us ('Judiazers') have troubled You (Gentile Converts To Christianity) with words, unsettling Your Souls, saying, 'You must be circumcised and keep the law'; to Whom We gave no such commandment. It seemed good to Us (Whole Church Council), being Assembled with One Accord, to Send Chosen Men to You (The Gentile Church of Antioch On The Orontes) with our beloved Barnabas and Paul, Men Who have risked their lives for the Name of Our Lord Jesus Christ. We (Whole Church Council) have therefore also Sent Judas and Silas, Who will also Report the Same Things by Word of Mouth. For it seemed Good to the Holy Spirit, and to Us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things: (4) That You (Our Fellow Brothers In Christ) abstain from things offered to idols, from blood, from things strangled, and from sexual immorality. If You keep yourselves from these, You will do well. Farewell!"

"So, Why Did Paul Go Ahead & Circumcise Timothy Anyway?"

A1 – Timothy Needed Legitimacy By Birth & Faith In Order To Lead
Paul Knew According To Official Jewish Doctrines:

That Unless Timothy, Who Was Considered An Illegitimate Jew At Best,
To Ever Be Accepted As A Church Leader,
He Would Have To Be Declared First A Legitimate Jew By Birth & Faith,
And Then A Legitimate Convert To Christianity By Faith.

A2 – Timothy Needed Fatherly Headship & Covering To Lead

1st Under God As His Legitimate Spiritual Father & Creator

2nd Under Paul As His Legitimate Spiritual & Adopted Physical Father
A3 – Paul Acted Accordingly In Action, Reason, & Spirit.

A3 – Paul Acted Accordingly In Action, Reason, & Spirit, & Did Not Contradict The Church Or The Faith
