A3) Jesus – See 1st Corinthians Chapter 15 Jesus Is The First Born – First Fruit From Among The Dead Jesus – Is The Third Of The *"First Fruits"*

"But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the 'First Fruits' of those who have fallen asleep. For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. But each one in his own order: Christ the 'First Fruits', afterward those who belong to Christ at His Second Coming!" 1st Corinthians 15:20-23 (NKJV)

Paul teaches us, "There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the Flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the Law of Sin & Death. For what the Law could not do in that it was weak through the Flesh, God did by sending His Own Son in the Likeness Of Sinful Flesh, on Account of Sin: He condemned Sin in the Flesh, that the righteous requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the Flesh but according to the Spirit. For those who live according to the Flesh set their minds on the things of the Flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. For to be Carnally Minded is Death, but to be Spiritually Minded is Life & Peace. Because the Carnal Mind is Enmity against God; for it is not subject to the Law of God, nor indeed can be. So then, those who are in the Flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the Flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they Do Not Belong To God! And if Christ is in You, the Body is Dead because of Sin, but the Spirit is Life because of Righteousness (Holiness). But if the Spirit of Him Who Raised Jesus from the Dead Dwells in You, He Who Raised Christ from the Dead will also give Life to Your Mortal Bodies through His Spirit Who Dwells in You!" **Romans 8:1-11 (NKJV)** A: Five Stories Interwoven Moses, Ruth, Jesus, Day Of Pentecost, & Today

Then there Appeared to them Divided Tongues of Fire, and One sat upon each of them. Now when the people heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be Baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ for the Forgiveness of Sins; and you shall Receive the Gift of the Holy Spirit! For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord Our God Will Call!" And with many other Words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be Saved from this perverse generation!" Then those who gladly received His Word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. Then Fear (Awe) came upon every soul, and Many Wonders & Signs were done through the apostles. Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. So, continuing daily with One Accord in the Temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, Praising God and having favor with all the people. Do Not Doubt Him Today! Do Not Let Satan Steal His Gift To You! If You Hear His Voice Today, Do Not Harden Your Hearts, Instead Draw Near To Him, And He Will Draw Near To You! God Has Given You His Will & His Promise For Your Life!

Paul Reminds Us Now, "Rejoice Always, Pray Without Ceasing, In Everything Give Thanks; For This is the Will of God in Christ Jesus for You! Do Not Quench the Holy Spirit! Do not Despise Prophecies! Test All Things; Hold Fast What is Good! Abstain from Every Form of Evil! And Now May the God of Peace Himself Sanctify You Completely; and May Your Whole Spirit, Soul, and Body Be Preserved Blameless (Holy) at the Coming of Our Lord Jesus Christ! He Who Calls You Is Faithful, Who also Will Do It!" 1st Thessalonians 5:16-24 (NKJV)
