"God Has Visited & Redeemed His People!"

Luke 1:57-80

Now Elizabeth's full time came for her to be delivered, and she brought forth a Son. When her neighbors & relatives heard how the Lord Had Shown Great Mercy To Her, They Rejoiced With Her. So it was, on the eighth day, that they came to circumcise the child; and they would have called him by the Name of His Father, Zacharias. But his mother said, "No; he shall be Called John!" But they said to her, "There is no one among your relatives who is called by this name!" So they made signs to his father as to what he desired to call him. And he asked for a writing tablet, and wrote, saying, "His Name is John!" So they all marveled. Immediately His Mouth Was Opened and His Tongue Loosed, & He Spoke, Praising God. Then Fear Came On All Who Dwelt Around Them; and all these sayings were discussed throughout all the hill country of Judea. And all those who heard them kept them in their hearts, saying, "What kind of child will this be?" And the Hand of the Lord was with Him (John). Now His Father Zacharias Was Filled With The Holy Spirit, and Prophesied, "Blessed is the Lord God of Israel, for He has Visited and Redeemed His People, and has raised up a Horn of Salvation for us In the House of His Servant David, as He spoke by the Mouth of His Holy Prophets, who have been since the world began, that we should be saved from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us, to perform the mercy promised to our fathers and to remember His Holy Covenant, the Oath which He Swore to Our Father Abraham. To grant us that we, being delivered from the hand of our enemies, might serve Him without fear, in Holiness and Righteousness before Him all the days of our life. And you, Child, will be called the Prophet of the Highest; for you will go before the Face Of The Lord To Prepare His Ways, To Give Knowledge Of Salvation To His People By The Remission Of Their Sins, Through The Tender Mercy Of Our God, with which the Dayspring From On High Has Visited Us; To Give Light To Those Who Sit In Darkness and The Shadow Of Death. To Guide Our Feet Into The Way Of Peace!" So the Child John Grew and Became Strong In The Spirit and was in the desert till the Day of His Manifestation to Israel. Luke 1:57-80 (NKJV)

We should recognize that this story concerning the birth of John the Baptist conforms to a unique Lukan format that is repeated 4 different times by the gospel writer in 6 consecutive passages concerning the events surrounding that First Christmas. Here in this passage we see the <u>Sign Fulfilled</u> and the <u>Evidence</u> <u>Of Fulfillment</u> that was given by the Archangel Gabriel to Zacharias followed by his <u>Response Of Praise</u> concluding the first of these four occurrences:

Luke also saw and drew upon the parallels of the circumstances, the method of the announcement, and the actual events surrounding the birth of Isaac to Abraham and Sarah.

This later parallel between the birth of Isaac and John is portrayed by Luke in the following:

Two Promises Made By Archangel Gabriel To Zacharias Come True

1) John Is Born

Now Elizabeth's full time came for her to be delivered and she brought forth a son! Luke 1:57

Through the life of John, God simultaneously remembers the faithfulness of Zacharias and Elizabeth, and blesses them, while also remembering and blessing Israel!

2) Zacharias & Elizabeth's Relatives & Neighbors Rejoice & Celebrate John's Birth
When her neighbors & relatives heard how the Lord had shown great mercy to her, and they came
rejoiced with her!"

Luke 1:58

The rejoicing recorded in verse 58 finally lifts the disgrace felt by Elizabeth because of her infertility.

The disgrace Elizabeth said she felt was being lifted by God in verse 25 is now officially a thing of the past and a matter of fact in the flesh & blood of John her son!

And while her relatives (Mary included) rejoice with her and show honor to her, Elizabeth chooses to give the honor to God instead:

Here Again Elizabeth Praise Her God

"The Lord has dealt with me, in the days when He looked on me, to take away my reproach among the people."

Luke 1:25

While Elizabeth remained faithful to God throughout the past nine months;

Zacharias has been under the judgment of God, remaining mute because of his unbelief.

John Name Means "God Is Gracious" / "Full Of God's Grace"

- 1) God Is Gracious To Zechariah & Elizabeth
- 2) God Is Gracious To Israel
- 3) God Is Gracious To The Whole World

At that Very Moment, Zachariah's Voice Returns & He Begins to Give God the Praise & Worship Due To Him!

This Sudden Intervention Of Zachariah's Praise From Being Mute

Is An Act Of God That Luke Calls A "Sign" & Today We Call A "Miracle"

And the angel answered and said to him, "I am Gabriel, who stands in the presence of God, and was sent to speak to you and bring you these glad tidings. But behold, you will be mute and not able to speak until the day these things take place, because you did not believe my words which will be fulfilled in their own time!"

Luke 1:19-20

Then fear (awe) came on all who dwelt around them; & all these sayings were discussed throughout all the hill country of Judea. And all those who heard them kept them in their hearts, saying, "What kind of child will this be?"

Luke 1:65-66b

Notice also that our story opens with a birth celebration centered around John's circumcision on the 8th day after his birth. In spite of a moment of doubt by Zacharias, both he and his wife are righteous followers of God because they have their son circumcised on the 8th day after his birth in accordance with the covenant God made Abraham and his descendants after him!
