But Paul called with a loud voice, saying, "Do Yourself no harm, for We are all here!" Then He called for a light, ran in, and fell down trembling before Paul and Silas. And He brought Them (Paul & Silas) out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be Saved?" So, They said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and You will be Saved, You and Your Household." Then They (Paul & Silas) Spoke (Rhema) the Word of the Lord to Him and to All Who Were in His House. And He took Them (Paul & Silas) the same hour of the night and washed Their Stripes. And immediately He and All His Family were Baptized. Now when He had brought them into His House, He set food before Them; and He Rejoiced, having Believed in God with All His Household.

Paul Also Taught Us To Praise God & Be Glad

When We Are Persecuted For His Name's Sake – Even While Chained In Prison In Philippi "But I want you to know, brethren, that the things which happened to me have actually turned out for the furtherance of the Gospel, so that it has become evident to the whole palace guard, and to all the rest, that my chains are in Christ; and most of the Brethren in the Lord, having become confident by my chains, are much more bold to Speak the Word without fear. Some indeed preach Christ even from envy and strife, and some also from goodwill: The former preach Christ from selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my chains; but the latter out of love, knowing that I am appointed for the Defense of the Gospel! What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is preached; and in this I rejoice, yes, and will rejoice. For I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your prayer and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, according to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain. But if I live on in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my labor; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell. For I am hard pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better. Nevertheless, to remain in the flesh is more needful for you. And being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy of faith, that your rejoicing for me may be more abundant in Jesus Christ by my coming to you again. Only let your conduct be worthy of the Gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the Faith of the Gospel, and not in any way terrified by your adversaries, which is to them a proof of perdition, but to you of Salvation, and that from God. For to you it has been granted on behalf of Christ, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake, having the same conflict which you saw in me and now hear is in me." Philippians 1:12-30

Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content: I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things, I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. I can do all things through Christ Who strengthens me. Nevertheless, you have done well that you shared in my distress. Now you Philippians know that in the beginning of the Gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church shared with me concerning giving and receiving but you only. For even in Thessalonica, you sent aid once and again for my necessities. Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that abounds to your account. Indeed, I have all and abound. I am full, having received from Epaphroditus the things sent from you, a sweet-smelling aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well pleasing to God. And My God Shall Supply ALL Your Needs According to His Riches in Glory by Christ Jesus. Now to Our God and Father Be Glory Forever & Ever. Amen!" Philippians 4:2-20
