"Joseph: A Man Who Always Followed God's Plan!"

Matthew Chapters 1-2 & Luke Chapters 1-2

The Book of the Genealogy of *Jesus Christ*, the <u>Son of David</u>, the Son of Abraham ... And Jacob begot <u>Joseph</u> the husband of Mary, of whom was born *Jesus Who* is called *Christ* ...

Matthew 1:1 & 16

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with Child of the Holy Spirit. Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly. But while He (Joseph) thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, Son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. And she will bring forth a Son, and You shall call His Name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins!" So, all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the Prophet (Isaiah), saying: "Behold, the virgin shall be with Child, and bear a Son, and They shall call His Name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with Us!" Then Joseph, being aroused from sleep, did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took to him his wife, and did not know her till she had brought forth her firstborn Son. And he called His Name Jesus. Matthew 2:18-25 Now when They (Wise Men) had departed (from the manger), behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream, saying, "Arise, take the young Child and His mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I bring you Word; for Herod will seek the young Child to destroy Him." When he arose, he took the young Child and His mother by night and departed for Egypt, and was there until the death of Herod, that it might be fulfilled which was Spoken by the Lord through the Prophet (Hosea), saying, "Out of Egypt I Called My Son!" Matthew 2:13-15 Now when Herod was dead, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, saying, "Arise, take the young Child and His mother, and go to the Land of Israel, for those who sought the young Child's Life are dead." Then He arose, and He took the young Child and His mother, and came into the Land of Israel. But when He (Joseph) heard that Archelaus was reigning over Judea instead of his father Herod, he was afraid to go there. And being warned by God in a dream, he turned aside into the region of Galilee. And he came and dwelt in a City called Nazareth, that it might be fulfilled which was Spoken by (the Lord through) the Prophets (Isaiah, Jeremiah, Zechariah, et.al.), "He shall be called a Nazarene!"

Matthew 2:19-23

And it came to pass in those days that a <u>decree</u> went out from Caesar Augustus that <u>all the world should be registered</u>. This census first took place while Quirinius was governing Syria. So, all went to be registered, everyone to his own City. <u>Joseph also went up from Galilee</u>, out of the City of Nazareth, into Judea, to the City of David, which is called Bethlehem, because He <u>was of the House and Lineage of David</u>, to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with Child. So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn *Son*, and wrapped *Him* in swaddling cloths, <u>and laid Him in a manger</u>, because there was no room for them in the inn.

Luke 2:1-7

Now when the <u>days of her purification according to the Law of Moses were completed</u>, They (Joseph & Mary) <u>brought Him (Jesus Christ) to Jerusalem to Present Him to the Lord (<u>as it</u></u>

is written in the Law of the Lord, "Every male who opens the womb shall be called Holy to the

Lord!"), And to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the Law of the Lord, ...

... "A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons!" ... So, when They (Joseph & Mary) had performed all things according to the Law of the Lord, They returned to Galilee, to their own City, of Nazareth. And the Child Grew and became Strong in Spirit, Filled with Wisdom; and the Grace of God was upon Him.

Luke 2:22-24 & 39-40

His Parents (Joseph & Mary) went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover. And when He (Jesus) was twelve years old, They went up to Jerusalem according to the Custom of the Feast. When They had finished the days (of the Feast), as They returned (home), but the Boy Jesus lingered behind in Jerusalem. And Joseph and His mother did not know it; but supposing Him to have been in the company, They went a day's journey, and sought Him among their relatives and acquaintances. So, when They did not find Him, They returned to Jerusalem, seeking Him ... Then He (Jesus) went down with Them (Joseph & Mary) and came to Nazareth, and was subject to Them, but His mother kept all these things in her heart. And Jesus increased in Wisdom and Stature, and in Favor with God and men.
