<u>APPENDIX</u>

Aeschylus Warrior, Author, & Playwright

Aeschylus was a Hoplite Soldier of Athens – A Veteran with 13 Battles in his lifetime, including the **Battles of Marathon & Salamis** within the greater **Persian Wars**. His Life as a Soldier colored his understanding of life, politics, religion, etc. One of his seven surviving tragic **Plays** deals with his life as a soldier - *The Persians*.

Only Seven Tragedies (Plays) attributed to Aeschylus have survived antiquity: *The Persians*, ¹ Seven Against Thebes, ² The Suppliants, ³ Prometheus Bound, ⁴ & the only Trilogy in ancient literature to have survived, *The Oresteia* ⁵⁻⁷ - the three tragedies of the trilogy are: *Agamemnon*, ⁵ *The Libation Bearers* ⁶ and *The Eumenides* ⁷. One hallmark of Aeschylean dramaturgy (study of drama) appears to have been his desire to write literary connected trilogies in which each play serves as a chapter in a continuous dramatic narrative.

It is a **Quote** from his **Play –** *Eumenides*⁷ that is quoted as the **Founding Central Sentiment for the birth of the Areopagus – The Council of Debate on Mars Hill**, that **Paul Orates** upon in **Acts Chapter 17:22-31** in the **City of Athens**.
