Then Jews (Religious Authorities) from (Pisidian) Antioch and Iconium came there (to Lystra); and having persuaded the multitudes, they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, supposing him to be dead. However, when the Disciples gathered around him (Paul's Body), he rose up and went into the city (of Lystra). And the next day Paul departed with Barnabas to Derbe. And when They (Paul & Barnabas) had preached the Gospel to the city (of Derbe) and made many Disciples, They returned to Lystra, Iconium, and (Pisidian) Antioch, strengthening the Souls of the Disciples, exhorting Them to continue in the faith, and saying (rhema / prophecy), "We must through many tribulations enter the Kingdom of God!" So, when They (Paul & Barnabas) had appointed (commissioned & ordained) Elders in every Church, and prayed with fasting, They (Paul & Barnabas) commended Them (Disciples) to the Lord in Whom They had believed (by faith).

## A5 – Persecution & Martyrdom

Non-Believers Immediately Begin To Persecute God's People & Bring Action Against The Gospel Then Jews (Religious Authorities) from (Pisidian) Antioch and Iconium came there (to Lystra); and having persuaded the multitudes, they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, supposing him to be dead.

"Why Did The People Of Lystra Rise Up Against Paul?"

1) The Religious Authorities Of The Larger Congregations Of Jews

From Pisidian Antioch & Iconium Stirred Up The People Of Lystra To Take Action Against The Perceived Heretical Preaching & Teaching Of Paul Concerning The Gospel Of Good News

2) Their Beliefs & Faith In Zeus Were Questioned & Made Useless In Light Of The Gospel But when the Apostles Barnabas and Paul heard this, they tore their clothes and ran in among the multitude, crying out and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We also are men with the same nature as you, and Preach (the Good News) to you that you should turn (repent) from these useless things to the Living God, Who made the heaven, the earth, the sea, and everything that is in them,"

Acts 14:14-16

"What Actually Happened To Paul When He Was Stoned?"

They stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, supposing him to be dead.

A

The Language Of This Stoning Has Three Realities:

1) Historical Jewish Law, 2) Miraculous Signs & Wonders, & 3) Paul's Later Accounting
1) Historical Jewish Law

Stoning In Jewish Law Needed At Least Three Witnesses
Of Which One Of Each Of The Following Had To Be Present:

A) Jewish Religious Authority, B) Court Appointed Authority, C) Eyewitness Accuser Further, Each Group Had To Give Approval & Participate,

& Each Group Had To Examine The Body To Declare The Victim Was Indeed Dead.

This Means Paul Was Not Almost Dead & Then Revived – He Was In Fact Stoned To Death!

2) Miraculous Signs & Wonders

The Language Chosen By Luke The Author Of Acts Is Spiritual - Miraculous And Is Explicitly Used To Invoke The Understanding Of A Divine Sign & Wonder Signifying A Resurrection!

**Paul Was Raised From The Dead!** 

... However, when the Disciples gathered around him (Paul's Body),

he rose up and went into the city (of Lystra) ...

Acts 14:20ab

3) Paul's Later Accounting Affirms The Miracle of Resurrection Presented In A High Chiasmata Format (High Set of Bookends)

#### **NOTE 5# Statements Of Qualification**

A1 Paul, "To our shame I say that we were too weak for that! But in whatever anyone is bold, I speak foolishly, I am bold also. 1 Are they Hebrews? So am I. 2 Are they Israelites? So am I. 3 Are they the seed of Abraham? So am I. 4 Are they ministers of Christ? I speak as a fool, I am more: in labors more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequently, in deaths often 5 ...

They (Paul & Barnabas) returned to Lystra, Iconium, and (Pisidian) Antioch, strengthening the Souls of the Disciples, exhorting Them to continue in the faith, and saying (rhema / prophecy), "We must through many tribulations enter the Kingdom of God!"

They Pray & Fast & Spend Time With Each Congregation Of Disciples.

Then They Commend & Reinforce The New Disciples To The Hand Of God In Faith ... And <u>prayed with fasting</u>, They (Paul & Barnabas) <u>commended</u> Them (Disciples) to the <u>Lord</u> in <u>Whom</u> They <u>had believed</u> (by faith) ... Acts 14:23
