Part I "The Ministry Of The Disciples & Barnabas Yield First Fruits In Antioch!"

Acts 11:19-24

Now Those (Disciples) Who were scattered after the Persecution (Diaspora of the Christians) that arose over Stephen traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus, and <u>Antioch</u>, Preaching the Word to <u>no one but the Jews only</u>. But some of Them (Disciples) were Men (Hellenist Jewish Born) from Cyprus and Cyrene, Who, when They had come to <u>Antioch</u>, spoke to the Hellenists (Unbelievers In Christ), Preaching the Lord Jesus. And the Hand of the Lord was with Them, and a "Great Number" Believed and Turned to the Lord. Then News (Good News) of these things came to the ears of the Church in Jerusalem (Whole Church), and They (Church Council Elders of Jerusalem) sent out Barnabas to go as far as <u>Antioch</u>. When Barnabas came (to <u>Antioch</u>) and had seen the Grace of God, he was <u>Glad</u>, and <u>Encouraged</u> Them All (New Hellenist Disciples), that with Purpose of Heart they should continue (in Relationship) with the Lord. For Barnabas was a <u>Good Man</u>, <u>Full of the Holy Spirit</u> and of <u>Faith</u>. And a "Great Many" People were added (in <u>Antioch</u>) to the Lord.

& The Persecution That Started After The Death of Stephen

Now Saul was consenting to <u>Stephen's death</u>. At that time, a great persecution arose against the Church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all <u>scattered</u> (*diaspora*) throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles. And devout men carried <u>Stephen to his burial</u>, and made great lamentation over him. As for Saul, he made havoc of the church, entering every house, and dragging off men and women, committing them to prison. Therefore, those who were <u>scattered</u> (*diaspora*) went everywhere Preaching the Word. Acts 8:1-4

"Who Exactly At First Was Saul Persecuting & Dragging Off In Chains Both In Jerusalem In This Passage & Later In Damascus In The Next Chapter?"

A

Predominately Gentile Converts To Christianity, But Also Jewish Converts To Christianity, Who Had Fled Jerusalem & Judea To Samaria & Damascus!

... "And they were all scattered (diaspora) throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria,

except the apostles." ... Acts 8:1

Q

"What Was The Outcome Of This Persecution & Scattering From Jerusalem & Judea To Samaria & Damascus?"

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The Word Of God's Good News Spread More Quickly Than If There Was No Persecution! "Therefore, those who were <u>scattered</u> (diaspora) <u>went everywhere</u> <u>Preaching the Word</u>."

Acts 8:4

Q: "Had The Persecution Changed Some Of These Converts Actions?" A: Yes! Many Returned To Only Taking Care Of God's Original Chosen People! Now Those (Disciples) Who were <u>scattered</u> after the Persecution (Diaspora of the Christians) that arose over Stephen traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus, and <u>Antioch</u>, Preaching the Word to <u>no one but the Jews only</u>. Acts 11:19

Q: "What Had The Persecution Done To The Other Converts Actions?"

A: It Intensified Their Determination & They Obediently Stayed The Course!

But some of Them (Disciples) were Men (Hellenist Born – Jewish Converts) from Cyprus and Cyrene, Who, when They had come to <u>Antioch</u>, spoke to the Hellenists (Unbelievers In Christ), <u>Preaching the Lord Jesus</u>. Acts 11:20

Q: "How Did The Lord Respond To Their Courage, Obedience, & Fervor For Him & His Mission?"

A: He Rewarded Them By Bringing A *"Great Number"* By Faith To Himself! And the Hand of the Lord was with Them,

and a "Great Number" Believed and Turned to the Lord! ... Acts 11:21

Q: "How Did The Church Council In Jerusalem Respond

To The Reports Of The Growth Among The Gentiles In Antioch?"

A: They Sent Out The Faithful Barnabas To Investigate These Matters!

Then News (Good News) of these things came to the ears of the Church in Jerusalem (Whole Church), and They (Church Council Elders of Jerusalem) sent out Barnabas to go as far as <u>Antioch</u>. Acts 11:22

Q: "Why Did The Jerusalem Church Council Of Elders Choose & Send Barnabas?"

A: Because Of His Past & Present Actions, & His Character & Faith In The Church!

Barnabas' Past Actions

And Joses, <u>who was also Named by the Apostles</u>, <u>Barnabas</u>, Which is Translated, 'Son of Encouragement', who was a Levite of the Country of Cyprus, who also having land, sold it, and brought the money and laid it at the apostles' feet. <u>Acts 4:36-37</u>

Barnabas' Past Actions

And when Saul had come to Jerusalem, <u>he tried to join the</u> Disciples (Followers); but They <u>were</u> <u>all afraid of him</u> and <u>did not believe that he was a</u> Disciple (Follower). But Barnabas (*The 'Son of Encouragement'*) took him and brought him to the Apostles. And He (Barnabas) declared to Them (Apostles) how He (Saul) had seen the Lord on the Road (to Damascus), and that He (Lord) Had Spoken (Rhema) to Him (Saul), and how He (Saul) had preached boldly at Damascus in the 'Name of Jesus' [And of Saul's Escape from the City of Damascus with the help of the Disciples/Followers there].

Barnabas' Present Actions

For Barnabas was a Good Man, Full of the Holy Spirit and of Faith! ... Acts 11:24a

Q: "What Did Barnabas See When He Arrived In Antioch?"

A: That God Had Poured Out His Mercy, Forgiveness & Grace

Upon The New Disciples Of His Son, Jesus Christ!

When Barnabas came (to Antioch) and had seen the Grace of God, he was Glad, ... Acts 11:23a

Q: "How Did Barnabas Respond After Seeing God's Actions Toward The New Disciples?"

A: He Encouraged, Instructed, & Spurred Them On In Their New Faith!

And (Barnabas) Encouraged Them All (New Hellenist Disciples),

that with Purpose of Heart they should continue (in Relationship) with the Lord ... Acts 11:23b

Q: "What Was The Result Of The Work Of The Hellenist Evangelists

& The Follow Up Work Of Barnabas In Antioch?"

A: God Rewarded Them Both Working Side By Side

By Bringing A "Great Many" By Faith To Himself!

And a "Great Many" People were added (in Antioch) to the Lord! ... Acts 11:24b

Let Us Be Found Day By Day To Be Like Those Early Gentile Evangelists & Barnabas, Not Counting The Cost, But Preaching The Word Of The Good News Of The Gospel of Jesus Christ Our Lord, In Season, & Out Of Season! Let Us Be Found Day By Day To Be Like Those Early Gentile Evangelists & Barnabas, Always Observing & Comprehending What God's Holy Spirit Is Doing, And Joining Him By Encouraging, Instructing, & Spurring On One Another In The Faith!
