**Scriptural Roots of Conviction** 

(Condemnation / Reprove)

Noun - Object / Thing

**Scriptural Roots of Convicting** 

(Condemn / Judge)

**Verb** - Action / Offering

Reprove: "To argue & convince using debate: logic, proof, & reason; in order to end a dispute, fallacy, false teaching, or misunderstood belief / truth!"

Condemn: "To declare one to be civilly, ethically, morally, or spiritually at opposition with the Spirit & Will of God; and out of relationship with others & God!"

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## **Scriptures On Conviction**

Jesus gets to the heart of the matter, "Why do you not understand My Speech (Teaching & Instruction)? Because you are Not Able to Listen to My Word. You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the Truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it. But because I Tell (Convict with) the Truth, you do not believe Me. Which of you Convicts Me of sin? And if I Tell (Convict with) the Truth, why do you not believe Me? He who is of God Hears God's Words; therefore, you do not hear, because you are not of God!"

Jesus Instructs us, "Nevertheless I <u>Tell</u> (<u>Convict</u> with) the <u>Truth</u>. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will Send Him to you. And when He has come, He will <u>Convict</u> the world: of sin, <sup>1</sup> and of righteousness, <sup>2</sup> and of judgment!" <sup>3</sup>

John 16:7-8

Paul Instructs us, "But if all prophesy, and an unbeliever or an uninformed person comes in, he is <u>Convinced</u> by all, he is <u>Convicted</u> by all. And thus the secrets of his heart are revealed; and so, falling down on his face, he will <u>Worship God</u> and <u>Report</u> (<u>Testify</u>) that <u>God is Truly Among</u> you.

1st Corinthians 14:24-25

#### **Scriptures On Reprove**

Solomon Writes to us, "My Son, Do Not Despise the <u>Chastening</u> of the Lord, nor Detest His <u>Correction</u>; for whom the Lord <u>Loves</u> He <u>Corrects</u>, Just as a father the son in whom he delights!"

Proverbs 3:11-12

Jesus Instructs us, "Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and <u>Tell</u> (<u>Reprove</u>) him his fault between you and him alone. If he <u>hears you</u>, you have gained your brother. But if he <u>will not hear</u>, take with you one or two more, that 'By the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.' And if he <u>refuses to hear</u> them, tell it to the church. But if he <u>refuses even to hear</u> the church, <u>let him be to you like a heathen and a tax collector." Matthew 18:15-17</u>

Paul Exhorts Timothy, "<u>Preach the Word!</u> Be ready in season and out of season. <u>Convince, Rebuke, Exhort, with all Longsuffering</u> and <u>Teaching</u>.

2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 4:2

#### **Handout For Self-Reflection**

14 "And to the Angel of the Church in Laodiceans Write, 'These Things Says (Rhema) the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the Creation of God: 15 I know your works, 1 that you are: neither cold 1a nor hot. 1b I could wish you were cold 1a or hot. 1b 16 So then, because you are lukewarm, 1c and neither cold 1a nor hot, 1b I will yomit you out of My Mouth. 17 Because you say: 'I am rich, 1d (I) have become wealthy, 1e and (I) have need of nothing', 1f and do not know that you are: wretched, 2a miserable, 2b poor, 2c blind, 2d and naked, 2e 18 I counsel you to buy from Me Gold Refined in the Fire, that you may be rich; 3c and White Garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; 3e and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. 3abd 19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Job Confesses, "Though I were Righteous, my own mouth would <u>Condemn</u> me; Though I were Blameless, it would prove me <u>Perverse!"</u>

Job 9:20

John Instructs us, "My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in <u>Deed</u> and in <u>Truth</u>. And by this we know that we are of the <u>Truth</u>, and shall <u>Assure</u> our hearts before Him. For if our heart <u>Condemns</u> us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things. Beloved, if our heart <u>Does Not Condemn</u> us, we have <u>Confidence</u> toward God."

## **Handout On Condemnation & Eternal Forgiveness Or Eternal Judgement**

Luke Records, There were also two others, criminals, led with Him to be put to death. And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left. Then Jesus Said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do!" And they divided His garments and cast lots. And the people stood looking on ... Then one of the criminals who were hanged blasphemed Him, saying, "If You are the Christ, save Yourself and us!" But the other, answering, rebuked him, saying, "Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation? And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong!" Then he said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when You Come into Your Kingdom!" And Jesus Said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise!"

Scriptural Roots of Repentance (Change of Mind / Penitence)

Noun - Object / Thing

**Scriptural Roots of Repent** (Turn Away & Turn Towards)

**Verb** – Action / Offering

Penitence: "To express true heartfelt & spiritual

contriteness, regret, remorse, & sorrow for one's sins & transgressions!"

Repent: "To turn away from a mind set on the flesh & selfishness,

and to turn toward the mind set on the Spirit & God;

a have a complete change of heart, mind, & will!

**Scriptures On Penitence & Repentance** 

Paul Instructs us, "For even if I Made you Sorry with my letter, I do not regret it; though I did regret it. For I perceive that the same Epistle Made you Sorry, though only for a while. Now I rejoice, not that you were Made Sorry, but that your Sorrow Led to Repentance. For you were Made Sorry in a Godly Manner, that you might suffer loss from us in nothing. For Godly Sorrow Produces Repentance leading to Salvation, not to be regretted; but the Sorrow of the World Produces Death. For observe this very thing, that you Sorrowed in a godly Manner: What Diligence it Produced in you, what Clearing of yourselves, what Indignation, what Fear, what Vehement Desire, what Zeal, what Vindication! In all things you proved yourselves to be Clear in this Matter.

## **Scriptures On Repent**

There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was blameless and upright, and one who feared God and shunned evil ... Job Said, "Listen, please, and let me speak; You (God) said, 'I will question you, and you shall answer Me.' I (Job) have heard of You by the hearing of the ear, but now my eye sees You. Therefore, I Abhor myself, and Repent in dust and ashes!"

Job 1:1 & 42:4-6

Jeremiah Tells us, "O Lord, are not Your Eyes on the Truth? You have stricken them, but they Have Not Grieved; You have consumed them, but they have Refused to Receive Correction. They Have Made Their Faces Harder Than Rock; they Have Refused to Return (to You)." Jeremiah 5:3

In those days, John the Baptist came Preaching in the Wilderness of Judea, and Saying (Preaching), "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at Hand!" For this is he who was Spoken of by the Prophet Isaiah, Saying: "The Voice of One Crying in the Wilderness: 'Prepare the Way of the Lord; Make His Paths Straight." ... "I (John) indeed Baptize you with Water Unto Repentance, but He Who Is Coming after Me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will Baptize you with the Holy Spirit and Fire." Matthew 3:1-3 & 11

Now after John (the Baptist) was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, Preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom of God, and Saying (Preaching), "The Time is Fulfilled, and the Kingdom of God is at Hand. Repent, and Believe in the Gospel!" Mark 1:14-15

#### First Sermon of the New Church at Pentecost

Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and Brethren, what shall we do?" Then Peter Said (Preached) to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be Baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ for the Remission of Sins; and you shall Receive the Gift of the Holy Spirit. For the Promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord Our God Will Call!" And with many other Words He (Peter) Testified and Exhorted them, Saying (Preached), "Be Saved from this Perverse Generation!" Then those who Gladly Received His Word were Baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. Acts 2:37-41
