Acts 13:42-52

"So, when the Jews went out of the Synagogue, the Gentiles begged that these Words (Gospel) might be preached to them the next Sabbath. Now when the Congregation had broken up, many of the Jews and Devout Proselytes (Gentile Converts) followed Paul and Barnabas, Who, speaking to Them (New Converts), persuaded Them (New Disciples) to continue in the Grace of God. On the next Sabbath, almost the whole city came together to Hear the Word of God (Full Gospel of Good News). But when the Jews (Religious & Secular Authorities) saw the multitudes, they were filled with envy; and contradicting and blaspheming, They opposed the Things (Truths of the Gospel) Spoken by Paul. Then Paul and Barnabas grew bold and Said (Rhema): It was necessary that the Word of God (Gospel) should be Spoken to you first; but since you reject It (God's Word), and judge yourselves unworthy of Everlasting Life, behold, We (Paul & Barnabas) turn to the Gentiles. For so the Lord has commanded Us: 'I (God) have set You (My Son) [& And All Of My True Followers] as a Light to the Gentiles, that You (My Son) [& And All Of My True Followers] should be for Salvation to the ends of the earth.' Now when the Gentiles heard This (God's Word), They were Glad and Glorified the Word of the Lord (Gospel of Good News). And as many as had been appointed to Eternal Life believed. And the Word of the Lord was being spread throughout all the region. RECALL

Jesus' Instructs His Followers About Persecution

<u>These Twelve</u> Jesus Sent Out and Commanded <u>Them</u>, Saying: "Do not go into the Way of the Gentiles (at first), and do not enter a City of the Samaritans (at first). But go rather to the "Lost Sheep of the House of Israel. And as you Go, Preach, Saying (Rhema), '<u>The Kingdom of Heaven is at Hand</u>.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. <u>Freely you have received</u>, <u>freely give</u>! Provide neither gold nor silver nor copper in your money belts, nor bag for your journey, nor two tunics, nor sandals, nor staffs; for a worker is worthy of his food. Now whatever city or town you enter, inquire who in it is worthy, and stay there till you go out. And when you go into a household, greet it. If the household is worthy, let your peace come upon it. But if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you. <u>And whoever will not receive you nor hear your</u> Words, when you depart from that house or city, shake off the dust from your feet. Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for the Land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the Day of Judgment than for that City (People)!"

RECALL

Jesus' Warning To His Followers On Testifying & Witnessing

Jesus Warned His Followers, "Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves. Therefore, be wise as serpents and harmless as doves. But beware of men, for they will deliver you up to councils and scourge you in their synagogues. You will be brought before governors and kings for My Sake, as a <u>Testimony</u> to them and to the Gentiles. But when they deliver you up, do not worry about how or what you should speak. For it will be given to you in that hour what you should speak; for it is not you who speak, but the <u>Spirit of Your Father Who</u> speaks in you. Now brother will deliver up brother to death, and a father his child; and children will rise up against parents and cause them to be put to death. And you will be hated by all for <u>My Name's Sake</u>. But he who endures to the end will be saved. When they persecute you in this city, flee to another. For assuredly, I say to you, you will not have gone through the Cities of Israel before the <u>Son of Man Comes</u> (Again). A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a servant above his master. It is enough for a disciple that he be like his teacher, and a servant like his master. If they have called the <u>Master of the House Beelzebub</u>, how much more will they call those of <u>His Household!</u>"

Jesus' Admonition To Be Obedient & Fear Not

Jesus Admonishes His Followers, "Therefore, do not fear them. For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, and hidden that will not be known. Whatever I Tell you in the dark, Speak in the light; and what you Hear in the ear, Preach on the housetops. And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him Who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's Will. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear; therefore, you are of more value than many sparrows. Therefore, Whoever Confesses Me before men, Him I will also Confess before My Father Who is in Heaven!" Matthew 10:26-33 (NKJV)
