Moses Commanded, "You shall hang up the Veil under the clasps, and shall bring in the Ark of the Testimony (Covenant) there within the Veil; and the Veil shall serve for you as a Partition between the Holy Place and the Holy of Holies. You shall put the Mercy Seat on the Ark of the Testimony (Covenant) in the Holy of Holies." ... Aaron and his sons Offered on the Altar of Burnt Offering and on the Altar of Incense, for all the Work of the Most Holy Place, and to Make Atonement for Israel, according to all that Moses the Servant of God had Commanded.

Exodus 26:33-34 & 1st Chronicles 6:49

The Old Testament Imperfect Way Vs. The New Testament Perfect Way

Paul Instructs, "Now even the First Covenant had regulations of divine worship and the earthly Sanctuary. For there was a Tabernacle prepared, the Outer One, in which were the lampstand and the table and the sacred bread; this is called the Holy Place. Behind the Second Veil there was a Tabernacle which is called the Holy of Holies, having a golden altar of incense and the Ark of the Covenant covered on all sides with gold, in which was a golden jar holding the manna, and Aaron's rod which budded, and the tables of the covenant; and above it were the Cherubim of Glory overshadowing the Mercy Seat; but of these things we cannot now speak in detail. Now when these things have been so prepared, the priests are continually entering the Outer Tabernacle performing the divine worship, but into the Second, only the high priest enters once a year, not without taking blood, which he offers for himself and for the sins of the people committed in ignorance. The Holy Spirit is signifying this, that the Way into the Holy Place has not yet been disclosed while the Outer Tabernacle is still standing, which is a symbol for the Present Time. Accordingly both Gifts and Aacrifices Are Offered Which Cannot Make the Worshiper Perfect in Conscience, since they relate only to food and drink and various washings, regulations for the body imposed Until a Time of Reformation. But when Christ Appeared as a High Priest of the Good Things to Come, He Entered Through the Greater and More Perfect Tabernacle, not made with hands, which is to say, not of this creation; and not through the blood of goats and calves, but Through His Own Blood, He Entered the Holy Place Once For All, Having Obtained Eternal Redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh, how much more will the Blood of Christ, Who Through the Eternal Spirit Offered Himself Without Blemish to God, Cleanse Your Conscience from Dead Works to Serve the Living God? For this reason, He is the Mediator of a New Covenant, so that, since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were committed under the First Covenant, those who have been called may receive the Promise of the Eternal Inheritance. For where a Covenant is, there must of necessity be the death of the one who made it. For a Covenant is valid only when men are dead, for it is never in force while the one who made it lives. Therefore, even the First Covenant was not inaugurated without blood. For when every Commandment had been spoken by Moses to all the people according to the Law, he took the blood of the calves and the goats, with water and scarlet wool and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book itself and all the people, Saying, 'This is the Blood of the Covenant which God Commanded you!' And in the same way he sprinkled both the tabernacle and all the vessels of the ministry with the blood. And according to the Law, one may almost say, all things are cleansed with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. Therefore, it was necessary for the copies of the things in the heavens to be cleansed with these, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these. For Christ Did Not Enter a Holy Place Made with Hands, a Mere Copy of the True One, but into Heaven Itself, Now to Appear in the Presence of God (the Father) for Us; Mor Was It that He Would Offer Himself Often, as the high priest enters the Holy Place year by year with blood that is not his own. Otherwise, He Would Have Needed to Suffer Often since the Foundation of the Borld; But Now Once at the Consummation of the Ages ..."

... "He Has Been Manifested to Put Away Sin by the Sacrifice of Himself. And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this comes judgment, so Christ also, Having Been Offered Once to Bear the Sins of Many, Will Appear a Second Time for Salvation Without Reference to Sin, to Those Who Eagerly Await Him!" Warnings Concerning Defiling The Holy of Holies With Abominations

Then He brought Me (Eziekiel) back by the way of the outer gate of the Sanctuary, which faces the east; and it was shut. The Lord said to Me, "This gate shall be shut; it shall not be opened, and no one shall enter by it, for the Lord God of Israel has entered by it; therefore it shall be shut. As for the prince, he shall sit in it as prince to eat bread before the Lord; he shall enter by way of the porch of the gate and shall go out by the same way." Then He brought me by way of the north gate to the front of the house; and I looked, and behold, the Glory of the Lord filled the House of the Lord, and I fell on my face. The Lord said to me, "Son of man, mark well, see with your eyes and hear with your ears all that I say to you concerning all the statutes of the House of the Lord and concerning all its Laws; and mark well the entrance of the House, with all exits of the Sanctuary. You shall say to the rebellious ones, to the house of Israel, 'Thus Says the Lord God, Enough of all your abominations, O House of Israel, when you brought in foreigners, Uncircumcised in Heart and Uncircumcised in Flesh, to be in My Sanctuary to Profane It, even My House, when you Offered My Food, the Fat and the Blood; for they made My Covenant Void, this in addition to all your abominations. And you have not kept charge of My Holy Things yourselves, but you have set foreigners to keep charge of My Sanctuary.' 'Thus Says the Lord God, No foreigner Uncircumcised in Heart and Uncircumcised in Flesh, of all the foreigners who are among the Sons of Israel, Shall Enter My Sanctuary. But the Levites who went far from Me when Israel went astray, who went astray from Me after their idols, shall bear the punishment for their iniquity. Yet they shall be ministers in My Sanctuary, having oversight at the gates of the House and ministering in the House; they shall slaughter the Burnt Offering and the Sacrifice for the People, and they shall stand before them to minister to them. Because they ministered to them before their idols and became a stumbling block of iniquity to the House of Israel, therefore I have sworn against them," Declares the Lord God, "That they shall bear the punishment for their iniquity. And they shall not come near to Me to serve as a priest to Me nor come near to, any of My Holy Things, to the Things that are Most Holy; but they will bear their shame and their abominations which they have committed. Yet I will appoint them to keep charge of the House, of all its service and of all that shall be done in it." Eziekiel 44:1-14

Isaiah Saw, In the Year that King Uzziah died, I (Isaiah) <u>Saw</u> (Epiphanic & Theophanic Vision) the Lord <u>Sitting on a Throne</u>, High and Lifted Up, and the Train of His Robe Filled the Temple. Above <u>It</u> (<u>Throne</u>) Stood <u>Seraphim</u>; Each One Had Six Wings: With Two (Wings) He Covered His Face, With Two (Wings) He Covered His Feet, and With Two (Wings) He Flew. ³ And One cried to Another and Said: "Holy, ¹ Holy, ² Holy ³ is the Lord of Hosts; The Whole Earth Is Full of <u>His Glory</u>!"
