Scriptures Concerning Blessing the Lord

Then I (John) Looked, and I (John) <u>Heard the Voice</u> of <u>Many Angels Around the Throne</u>, the (Four) Living Creatures, and the (Twenty-Four) Elders; and the Number of Them (Angels) was Ten Thousand Times Ten Thousand, and Thousands of Thousands, <u>Saying with a Loud Voice</u>: "Worthy Is the Lamb Who Was Slain <u>To Receive</u>: Power, Riches, Wisdom, Strength, Honor, Glory and Blessing (Praise)!" And Every Creature Which Is In Heaven, On the Earth, Under the Earth, in the Sea, and All That Are in Them, <u>I Heard Saying</u>: "Blessing (Praise), Honor, Glory and Power Be to Him Who <u>Sits on the Throne</u>, and to the Lamb, Forever and Ever!" Then the Four Living Creatures <u>Said</u>, "Amen!" And the Twenty-Four Elders <u>Fell Down</u> and <u>Worshiped</u> Him Who Lives Forever and Ever!

A Psalm Of David. "Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, Bless His Holy Name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His Benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. The Lord executes righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed. He made known His Ways to Moses, His Acts to the children of Israel. Then One of the (Twenty-Four) Elders Answered, Saying to Me (John), "These Who are Clothed in the White Robes, Who are They, and where have They come from?" I (John) Said to Him, "My lord, you know!" And He Said to Me (John), "These are the Ones Who come out of the great tribulation, and They have Washed Their Robes and made Them White in the Blood of the Lamb. For this Reason (Washed White in the Blood of the Lamb), They are Before the Throne of God; and They Serve Him 'Day and Night' in <u>His Temple</u>; ...

... And He Who <u>Sits on the Throne</u> will Spread <u>His Tabernacle</u> over <u>Them</u>. <u>They</u> will hunger no longer, nor thirst anymore; nor will the sun beat down on <u>Them</u>, nor any heat; for the <u>Lamb</u> in the <u>Center of the Throne</u> will be <u>Their</u> <u>Shepherd</u>, and will guide <u>Them</u> to 'Springs of the Water of Life'; and <u>God</u> will wipe every tear from <u>Their</u> eyes!" Paul Writes, "Therefore, He Says: 'Awake, you who sleep, Arise from the dead, and Christ will give you Light.' See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Therefore, do not be unwise, but understand what the Will of the Lord is. And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, <u>Giving Thanks</u> (<u>Gratitude</u>) <u>Always for All Things</u> to God the Father in the Name of Our Lord Jesus Christ, submitting to one another in the fear of God." For it is good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them. We have an Altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. For the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned outside the camp. Therefore, Jesus also, that He Might Sanctify the People with His Own Blood, suffered outside the gate. Therefore, let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His Reproach. For here we have no continuing city, but we seek the one to come. Therefore, by Him Let Us Continually Offer the Sacrifice of Praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, Giving Thanks to His Name. But do not forget to do good and to share, for with Such Sacrifices God Is Well Pleased." Hebrews 13:8-16
