Nor Can They Prove the Things of Which They Now Accuse Me. But this I (Paul) Confess to You (Felix), that According to the 'Way' Which They Call (Judge) a Sect, ^{2c} So, I Worship the God of My Fathers, Believing 'All Things' Which are Written in the Law and in the Prophets. 2d I Have Hope in God, Which They Themselves Also Accept, That There Will Be A 'Resurrection of the Dead', Both of the 'Just and the Unjust'. This Being So (An Established Fact), 'I (Paul) Myself Always Strive To Have A Conscience Without Offense Toward God and Men.' Now After Many Years (Almost Five), I Came to Bring Alms and Offerings to My Nation, in the Midst of Which Some Jews from Asia Found Me (Paul) Purified in the Temple, Neither With a Mob 2a Nor With Tumult. 2d They Ought To Have Been Here Before You (Governor) To Object If They Had Anything Against Me. 2 Or Else Let Those Who Are Here Themselves (Inner Circle of the Sanhedrin) Say If They Found Any Wrongdoing In Me 2a / 2b While I Stood Before The Council (of the Sanhedrin), Unless It Is For This One Statement Which I (Paul) Cried Out (Testified To), Standing Among Them, 'Concerning the Resurrection of the Dead' I Am Being Judged By You (Governor) This Day!" 2c Acts 24:10-21 (NKJV)

"And They <u>Neither Found</u> Me (Paul) ² in the Temple <u>Disputing with Anyone</u> ^{2a} <u>Nor Inciting the</u>
Crowd, ^{2d} either in the Synagogues or in the City. <u>Nor Can They Prove</u> the <u>Things</u> of Which
They <u>Now Accuse</u> Me. But this I (Paul) ² <u>Confess</u> to You (Felix), that <u>According</u> to the 'Way' Which
They Call (Judge) a Sect. ^{2c} So, I Worship the God of My Fathers, Believing 'All Things' Which
are Written in the Law and in the Prophets." ^{2d}

Paul's <u>Defense / Debate Strategy</u> Focuses Next On What They As The Religious Authorities
Have Conveniently Left Out Of Their "Official Accusations" – Their Own Beliefs & Doctrines
Which <u>Are In Complete Agreement With</u> Paul's Testified To Beliefs & Doctrines
'Concerning The Resurrection From The Dead'

On Putting The Inner Circle of the Sanhedrin's Council Official Accusations

Within The Actual Events As They Unfolded In A Strict Chronological Order of Events "Now After Many Years (Almost Five), I Came to <u>Bring Alms</u> and <u>Offerings</u> to My Nation, in the Midst of Which Some Jews from Asia Found Me (Paul) <u>Purified</u> in the Temple, <u>Neither</u> With a Mob ^{2a}
Nor With Tumult." ^{2d}

Paul's <u>Defense / Debate Strategy</u> Now Focuses On Making Those Responsible For His Captivity & Trial, To Try To Prove Any Of Their Accusations

1) "They (Jews from Asia) <u>Ought To Have Been Here Before</u> You (Governor) To Object If They Had Anything Against Me." ^{2a / 2d}

2) "Or Else <u>Let</u> Those Who Are Here Themselves (Inner Circle of the Sanhedrin) <u>Say</u>
If They Found Any Wrongdoing In Me ^{2a/2b} While I Stood Before Their Council."

Paul's <u>Defense / Debate Strategy</u> Focuses Finally On The <u>Main Point Of Contention</u> Between Judaism & The Whole World Vs. <u>Christianity's Central Claim</u>:

'The Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the Dead!'

3) "Unless It Is For This One Statement Which I (Paul) ² Cried Out (Testified To), Standing Among Them, 'Concerning the Resurrection of the Dead' I Am Being Judged By You (Governor) This Day!" ^{2c}
