"Paul's Appeal To His Brothers: From Jewish Zealot To Christian Convert To Exile For The Faith!" Acts 21:40 & 22:1-21

So, when He (Commander / Tribune) had given Him permission, Paul stood on the stairs and motioned with His Hand to the People (Jews). And then there was a Great Silence ... Then He (Paul) Spoke to Them in the Hebrew Language, saying, "Brethren (Jews) and Fathers (Sanhedrin), Hear My Defense before You now!" And when They heard that He spoke to Them in the Hebrew Language, They kept all the more silent. "I am indeed a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought up in this City (Jerusalem) at the Feet (Authority & Teaching) of Gamaliel (Prominent Member of the Pharisees & Sanhedrin Council), taught according to the strictness of our Fathers' Law, and was zealous toward God as You All are today. I Persecuted this Way (Christianity) to the death, binding and delivering into prisons both men and women, as also the High Priest bears Me Witness, and all the Council of the Elders (Sanhedrin), from Whom I also Received Letters to the Brethren, and went to Damascus to bring in chains even Those Who were there to Jerusalem to be punished. Now it happened, as I journeyed and came near Damascus at about noon, suddenly a Great Light from Heaven (Epiphany) Shone around Me. And I fell to the ground and Heard a Voice Saying (Theophany & Rhema) to me, 'Saul, Saul, why are You Persecuting Me?' So I answered, 'Who are You, Lord?' And He said to Me, 'I AM Jesus of Nazareth, Whom You Are Persecuting.' And Those Who were with Me indeed saw the Light and They were afraid, but They did not hear the Voice of Him Who Spoke (Theophany & Rhema) to Me. So I said, 'What shall I do, Lord?' And the Lord Said (Theophany & Rhema) to Me, 'Arise and Go into Damascus, and there You will be told all things which are appointed for You to do.' And since I <u>could not see</u> for the Glory of that Light (Epiphany), being led by the hand of Those Who were with Me, I came into Damascus. Then a certain Ananias, a Devout Man according to the Law, having a Good Testimony with all the Jews Who dwelt there, came to Me; and He stood and Said (Rhema) to Me, 'Brother Saul, receive your sight.' And at that same hour I looked up at Him. Then He (Ananias) Said (Rhema), 'The God of Our Fathers has chosen You that you should know His Will, and See the Just One (Epiphany), and Hear the Voice of His Mouth (Theophany & Rhema). For You will be His Witness to All Men of what You Have Seen (Epiphany) and Heard (Theophany & Rhema). And Now Why Are You Waiting? Arise and Be Baptized, and Wash Away Your Sins, Calling on the Name of the Lord.' Now it happened, when I returned to Jerusalem and was Praving in the Temple, that I was in a Trance and Saw Him (Epiphany) Saying (Theophany & Rhema) to Me, 'Make Haste and Get Out of Jerusalem Quickly, for They will not receive Your Testimony Concerning Me.' So I said, 'Lord, They know that in Every Synagogue I imprisoned and beat Those Who Believe (By Faith) on You. And when the Blood of Your Martyr Stephen was shed, I also Was Standing By Consenting to His Death, and Guarding the Clothes of Those Who Were Killing Him.' Then He (Epiphany) Said (Theophany & Rhema) to Me, 'Depart, for I Will Send Acts 21:40 & 22:1-21 (NKJV) You far from Here (Jerusalem) to the Gentiles."

COMPARE - These Three Defenses With Paul's Other Account to the Church in Galatia Paul Writes, "But I make known to You, Brethren, that the Gospel which was Preached by Me is not According to Man. For I neither received it from Man, nor was I taught it, but it came through the Revelation of Jesus Christ. For You have heard of My Former Conduct in Judaism, how I Persecuted the Church of God beyond measure and tried to destroy It. And I Advanced in Judaism beyond many of My Contemporaries in My Own Nation, being more exceedingly zealous for the traditions of My Fathers. But when it pleased God, Who Separated Me from My Mother's Womb and Called Me through His Grace, to Reveal His Son in Me, that I might Preach Him Among the Gentiles, I did not immediately confer with flesh and blood, nor did I go up to Jerusalem to Those Who Were Apostles Before Me; but I went to Arabia, and returned again to Damascus. Then after three years, I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and remained with Him fifteen days. But I saw none of the other Apostles except James, the Lord's Brother. Now concerning the things which I Write to You, indeed, before God, I do not lie. Afterward I went into the Regions of Syria and Cilicia. And I was unknown by Face to the Churches of Judea which were in Christ. But They were hearing only, 'He Who formerly persecuted Us now Preaches the Faith which He once tried to destroy.' And They Glorified God in Me." Galatians 1:11-24

3) The Title of the Name of the God - Invoked As A Divine Witness ³

4) The Use of a Divine Vision - God Himself Stands as Their Authority ⁴

Now Let's Compare Stephen's & Paul's Two Defenses

And Stephen Said (in the <u>Hebrew Language</u>), "Brethren (Jewish Brothers) and Fathers (Religious Leaders), Listen: The God of Glory <u>Appeared</u> to Our Father Abraham when He was in Mesopotamia, before He dwelt in Haran ..."¹⁻³

Then Paul Spoke "Brethren (Jews) and Fathers (Sanhedrin), Hear My Defense before You now!" And when They heard that He spoke to Them in the <u>Hebrew Language</u>, They kept all the more silent. ¹⁻² Acts 22:1-2

Paul Continued, "Then He (Ananias) Said (Rhema), 'The God of Our Fathers has chosen You that you should know His Will, and See the Just One (Epiphany), and Hear the Voice of His Mouth (Theophany & Rhema). For You will be His Witness to All Men of what You Have Seen (Epiphany) and Heard (Theophany & Rhema)."³ Acts 22:14-15

But Stephen, being *Full of the Holy Spirit*, **Gazed** (Epiphany) into Heaven and **Saw** (Vision) the **Glory of God**, and Jesus <u>Standing</u> at the Right Hand of God, and then He said, "Look! *I* See (*Divine Vision*) the Heavens Opened and the Son of Man <u>Standing</u> at the Right Hand of God!"⁴

Acts 7:55-56 Paul Recounts, "Now it happened, as I journeyed and came near Damascus at about noon, suddenly a Great Light from Heaven (Epiphany) Shone around Me. And I fell to the ground and Heard a Voice Saying (Theophany & Rhema) to me, 'Saul, Saul, why are You Persecuting Me?' So I answered,

Now there was a Disciple at Damascus named Ananias; and the Lord Said (Rhema) to Him in a Vision (Epiphany & Theophany), "Ananias!" And he replied, "Here I am, Lord!" And the Lord Commanded Him, "Get up and go to the Street called Straight, and inquire at the House of Judas for a man from Tarsus named <u>Saul</u>, for he is <u>Fasting</u> & <u>Praying</u> (for these <u>last three days</u>)" And in a Vision (Epiphany & Theophany), He (Saul) has seen a man named <u>Ananias</u> coming in and putting His Hand on Him, so that He <u>might receive His Sight</u> (Healing of <u>Physical Sight</u> & Transformation by <u>Divine</u> <u>Sight</u>)." Then Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this Man, how much harm He has done to Your Saints in Jerusalem." "And here He has Authority (Appointed Both Praeco & Procurator) from the Chief Priests to bind All Who Call on Your Name!" But the Lord Said (Rhema) to Him (Ananias), "Go! For He (Saul) is a <u>Chosen Vessel of Mine to bear</u> My Name before Gentiles, Kings, and the Children of Israel. For I will show Him how many things He <u>must suffer for</u> My Name's Sake!" And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying His Hands on Him (Saul), He (Ananias) Said (Rhema), "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, Who <u>Appeared</u> to You on the road as You came, (He) Has Sent Me that You <u>may receive</u> Your Sight and <u>be filled</u> with the Holy Spirit!"

Paul 2nd Appeal Goes Further By Appealing To God's Three Divine Personal Witnesses In ONE ¹⁻³ "Then He (Ananias) Said (Rhema), 'The God of Our Fathers ¹ has chosen You that you should know His Will, ³ and See the Just One (Epiphany) ², and Hear the Voice of His Mouth (Theophany & Rhema). ³ For You will be His Witness to All Men of what You Have Seen (Epiphany) and Heard (Theophany & Rhema)."²

Paul 3rd Appeal Found Later In His Defense Before Governor Festus, King Agrippa & Queen Bernice Appeals Directly to the <u>Authority</u> of Jesus Christ's <u>Command</u>

To <u>Convict All Men's Souls</u> By His Witness to the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ

Jesus Appearing in the Heavenly Light (Epiphany), Spoke (Rhema) by a Divine Command, "But rise and stand on our feet; for I have appeared (epiphany) to You (Paul) for this purpose, to make You a Minister and a Witness both of the things which You have seen (epiphany) and of the things which I will yet reveal (epiphany) to You. I (Jesus) will deliver You from the Jewish People, as well as from the Gentiles, to Whom I Now Send You, to Open Their Eyes, in order to Turn Them from Darkness to Light, and from the Power of Satan to God, that They May Receive Forgiveness of Sins and an Inheritance among Those Who Are Sanctified by Faith in Me."
