"Persecution Ended – Set Free For Mission!"

Acts 16:35-40

... And when it was day, the Magistrates sent the Officers, saying, "Let those men go!" So, the Keeper of the Prison reported these words to Paul, saying, "The Magistrates have sent to let You go. Now therefore depart, and go in peace." But Paul said to Them (Officers), "They (Magistrates) have beaten Us (Paul & Silas) openly, uncondemned Romans, and have thrown Us into prison. And now do They put Us out secretly? No indeed! Let Them come Themselves and get Us out!" And the Officers told these words to the Magistrates, and They (Magistrates) were afraid when They heard that They (Paul & Silas) were Romans. Then They came and pleaded with Them and brought Them out, and asked Them to depart from the City (Philippi). So, They (Paul & Silas) went out of the prison and entered the House of Lydia; and when They (Paul & Silas) had seen the Brethren, They encouraged Them and departed. Acts 16:35-40 (NKJV)

"What Was The Previous Context For Which The Magistrates Sent For The Jailer The Next Morning?"

A1 – Paul & Silas Had Been Wrongly Accused In A Public Trial The Day Before

... But when Her Owners saw that their hope of gain was gone [The Evil Spirit Was Exorcised Out Of The Slave Girl They Owned], They seized Paul and Silas and dragged Them into the Marketplace (City Square) before the Rulers (Proconsul of the City of Philippi)

... And when They had brought Them to the Magistrates, They said, "These Men are Jews, and They are disturbing Our City. They advocate customs (beliefs) that are not lawful for Us as Romans to accept (receive) or practice (observe)!" ... Acts 16:19-21

A2 – Paul & Silas Had Been Wrongly Beaten In Public The Day Before ... The Crowd joined in unison in attacking Them (Paul & Silas), and the Magistrates tore the garments off Them and gave orders to beat Them with rods. And when They had inflicted many blows upon Them ... Acts 16:22-23a

A3 – Paul & Silas Had Been Wrongly Put Into Prison The Night Before

... They (Magistrates) threw Them into prison, ordering the Jailer to keep Them safely. Having received this order, He (Jailer) put Them (Paul & Silas) into the inner prison Acts 16:23bc-24 and fastened Their Feet in the stocks.

"What Were The City Official's Hoping For By Letting Paul & Silas Go?"

A1

That They Would Make No More Problems For Them & Just Leave Peaceably On Their Own. A2

That They Would Not Go To Court As Free Roman Citizens & Demand Justice ... And when it was day, the Magistrates sent the Officers, saying, "Let those men go!" So, the Keeper of the Prison reported these words to Paul, saying, "The Magistrates have sent to let You go. Now therefore depart, and go in peace." ... Acts 16:35-36

"What Was Paul's Response To Their Offer Of Being Set Free?"

He Demanded Justice As A Free Roman Citizen

... So, They (Paul & Silas) went out of the prison and entered the House of Lydia; and when They (Paul & Silas) had seen the Brethren, They encouraged Them and departed ... Acts 16:40

They Choose Not To Press The Issue Further As Citizens Of Rome, In Order To Be Able To Return Peaceably In The Future In Order To Carry Out Their 7-Part Longer Plan For God's People, The Church: Visit, Report, Encourage, Strengthen, Preach, Teach, & Ordain!

Paul Revisited Philippi 2 Or 3 More Times

1st Return Macedonian Visit

... After the uproar had ceased, Paul called the Disciples to Himself, embraced Them, and departed to go to again to <u>Macedonia</u>. Now when He had <u>gone over that whole</u> Region and encouraged Them with Many Words, He came to Greece ... Acts 20:1-2

2nd Return Macedonian Visit

... He (Paul) came to Greece and stayed three months. And when the Jews plotted against Him as Ge was about to sail to Syria, He decided to <u>Return</u> through Macedonia. And Sopater of Berea <u>Accompanied</u> Him to Asia (Minor), also Aristarchus and Secundus of the Thessalonians, and Gaius of Derbe, and Timothy, and Tychicus and Trophimus of Asia (Minor). These (Seven) Men, going ahead, waited for Us at Troas. But We sailed away from Philippi after the Days of Unleavened Bread, and in five days joined Them at Troas, where We stayed seven days. <u>Acts 20:3-6</u>

3rd Return Macedonian Visit – Between His Two Roman Captivities In Prison

Paul Writes, ... "As I urged you when I went again into Macedonia, remain in Ephesus that You may charge some that They teach no other doctrine"... 1st Timothy 1:3 Paul Also Writes to the Church at Philippi, ... "And being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with You (Church in Philippi) All for Your Progress and Joy of Faith, that Your Rejoicing for Me may be more Abundant in Jesus Christ by My Coming to You Again!"

Philippians 1:25-26

Paul Reminds The Philippians & Us Again Today What An Honor & Privilege It Is To Be Counted Worthy To Suffer For The Sake Of The Name & Mission Of Jesus Christ Our Coming King & Lord!

... "Only <u>Let Your Conduct Be Worthy</u> of the Gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see You or I am absent, I may hear of <u>Your Affairs</u>, that <u>You Stand Fast in One Spirit</u>, <u>With One Mind</u> <u>Striving Together</u> for the Faith of the Gospel, and <u>not in any way</u> <u>Terrified by Your Adversaries</u>, which is to <u>Them a Proof of Perdition</u>, but to You of <u>Salvation</u>, and that from God. For to You <u>it</u> <u>has been granted on Behalf of</u> Christ, <u>not only to</u> <u>Believe in Him</u>, <u>but also to Suffer for</u> <u>His Name</u> <u>Sake</u>, <u>Having the Same Conflict</u> which You saw in <u>Me</u> and now hear is in <u>Me</u>. Philippians 1:27-30

C.S. Lewis once wrote in his book, *"The Weight of Glory"*, *"A man may have to die for his country, but no man must, in an exclusive sense, live for his country. He who surrenders himself without reservation to the temporal claims of a nation, or a party, or a class, is rendering to Caesar that which, of all things, most emphatically only belongs to God, Himself!"*
