This Story About Paul's Conversion & His Life Has A Three-Year Hiatus (34 A.D. – 37 A.D.)

With Separate Activity Under The Holy Spirit's Influence Built Into Its Context.

CONTEXT

However, Luke As A Historian Did Not Include This Three-Year Hiatus In His Official Record Of *"The History Of The Christian Church Part II"* – Entitled *"Acts Of The Apostles"*.

(In The Year 34 A.D.)<sup>1</sup> Ananias went his way and entered the house; and <u>laying his hands on him</u> (Saul), he (Ananias) Said (Rhema), "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, Who Appeared to you on the road as you came, (He) <u>has sent</u> me that you <u>may receive</u> Your Sight and <u>be filled</u> with the Holy Spirit!" Immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and <u>he received</u> His Sight (Healing of Physical Sight & Transformation by Divine Sight) at once; and he <u>arose</u> and (he) <u>was baptized</u>. So, when he had received food, he was strengthened. Then Saul spent some days with the Disciples at Damascus.<sup>1</sup> Acts 9:17-19 (NKJV)

But Saul <u>increased all the more in strength</u>, and <u>confounded the Jews</u> who dwelt in Damascus, proving that this 'Jesus Is The Christ!"" Now after many days were past, the <u>Jews plotted to kill him</u>. But <u>their plot became known</u> to Saul. And They (Jews) watched the gates day and night, to kill him. Then the Disciples took him (Saul) by night and let him down through the wall in a large basket (where he made his escape to Jerusalem).<sup>2</sup>

Paul says to the Church In Galatia, "But I make known to you, brethren, that the Gospel <u>which</u> <u>was preached by me is not according to man</u>. For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught <u>it</u>, but it came through the Revelation of Jesus Christ." <sup>1</sup> "For you have heard of my former <u>conduct in Judaism</u>, how I persecuted the Church of God beyond measure and tried to destroy it. And I advanced in Judaism beyond many of my contemporaries in my own nation, being more exceedingly zealous for the traditions of my fathers."<sup>1</sup> "But when it pleased God, Who separated me from my mother's womb and Called Me Through His Grace, to Reveal His Son in me, that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately confer with flesh and blood, nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me; but I went to Arabia, <sup>1</sup> and returned again to Damascus."<sup>2</sup> "Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and remained with him fifteen days. But I saw none of the other Apostles except James, the Lord's Brother. Now concerning the things which I write to you, indeed, <u>before God</u>, I do not lie."<sup>2</sup> "Afterward, I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia (Tarsus). And I was unknown by face to the Churches of Judea which were in Christ</u>. But they were hearing only, "He who formerly persecuted us, now preaches the faith which he once tried to destroy!" And they Glorified God in me."<sup>2</sup>

#### **EVIDENCE – Corinthians**

Paul says to the Church In Corinth, "<u>In Damascus the Governor (Ethnarch)</u>, <u>under Aretas (IV)</u> <u>the King, was guarding the City of the Damascenes with a garrison, desiring to arrest me</u>; but I was let down in a basket through a window in the wall, and escaped (<u>from his hands Governor</u> (<u>Ethnarch</u>), <u>under Aretas (IV) the King</u>)."<sup>2</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 11:32-33 (NKJV)

Insert Here Now The Official Roman History By Josephus, Which Confers Validity To The Biblical History In The New Testament (Matthew, Mark, & Luke) Concerning The History Of The Nabataean Kingdom & The Kingdom Of Israel EVIDENCE – Historian Josephus

King Aretas (IV)'s Daughter - Phasaelis, was married to Herod Antipas, otherwise known as Herod the Tetrarch. Phasaelis fled to her father when she discovered her husband intended to divorce her in order to take a new wife, Herodias, the wife of his brother, Herod II, & mother of Salome. Antipas married Herodias, and it was opposition to this marriage, as a polygamous, and an adulterous affair, that led to the eventual beheading of John the Baptist. It was John that pointed out that Herodias never divorced her Husband, she just left him, and then simply married See Also Mark 6:17-29 & Matthew 14:3-12 & Luke 3:18-20 again to gain power & prestige. In response to the public disgrace of his daughter, Phasaelis, Aretas (IV) invaded Herod Antipas' domain and defeated his army with the help of Philip the Tetrarch's army. Herod's brother Philip wanted to see his brother defeated and removed from power, for his perverse actions against his other brother, Herod II. Herod Antipas was able to barely escape with his life because of the help of a reinforced Roman Garrison in the area, ordered to protect him. Herod Antipas then appealed to Emperor Tiberius, who ordered Lucius Vitellius the Elder, the Governor of Syria, to immediately attack Aretas (IV). Vitellius gathered his Legions and moved southward, stopping for a short time in Jerusalem for the Passover of AD 37, to keep any insurrection of occurring among the Jews.

It was at the time of the Passover Festival, that news from Rome concerning Emperor Tiberius's recent death was delivered to Lucius Vitellius. Also, a set of new orders from Emperor Caligula was delivered to cease and desist the planned invasion of Nabataea. Finally, a new peace treaty and seal of authority was sent to Lucius to take to King Aretas (IV). This new formal agreement between the New Roman Emperor Caligula and King Aretas (IV) would allow the Nabataean Kingdom the official rights & authority to govern the Northern Syrian Province of Rome in place of the exiled, Herod Antipas. So, In the Year 37 AD, Emperor Caligula transferred all power and control of the Syrian Province of Rome, with Damascus as its Capitol City, to the Kingship Of Aretas (IV) of Nabataea, with a Roman Garrison nearby in a supportive and overseer role.

But their plot became known to Saul. And They (Jews & Nabateans together) watched the gates day and night, to kill him. Then the Disciples took him (Saul) by night and let him down through the wall in a large basket (where he made his escape to Jerusalem).<sup>2</sup>
