

And when the Jews plotted against Him (Paul) as He was about to sail to Syria, He decided to return through Macedonia. And Sopater of Berea accompanied Him to Asia (Minor), so Aristarchus, and Secundus of the Thessalonians, Gaius of Derbe, Timothy, Tychicus and Trophimus of Asia. These Men, Going Ahead, Waited for Us (Paul & Sopater) at Troas. But We sailed away from Philippi after the Days of Unleavened Bread, and in five days joined Them (The Other Six Men) at Troas, where We (Seven + One - All Together) stayed seven days.

After these things, the Lord Appointed Seventy Others also, and Sent Them Two-By-Two Before His Face into Every City and Place Where He Himself was About to Go. Then He Said to Them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves. Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road. But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this House.' And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you. But it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment than for you. And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades. He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you rejects Me, and he who rejects Me rejects Him Who Sent Me." Then the Seventy Returned with Joy, Saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your Name." And He Said to Them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven."
