## City Of Philippi

The City Of Philippi was an Important Center in Southeastern Europe In the Modern & Ancient Region of Macedonia:

- 1) Main Roman City & Colony of Macedonia Lying on the "Via Egnatia" This is the Main East – West Road Across Europe to Macedonia to Asia Minor – East
- 2) *Philippi* (Located Between the *Strymon & Nestos River Systems*) Was An Important Cargo & Agricultural Center of Trade
- 3) Main Retirement Center for All Veterans of 25 Years or More Service To Rome
- 4) Main Seat Of Government For Rome To All Asian Eastern Provinces "lus Italicum" The Official Seat Of Rome Answering To Rome Alone - Named In Honor Of Octavian's Victory Over Marc Antony in 31 B.C.
- 5) No Poll Or Property Taxes Were Paid To Province Or Rome In This City "Duty Free City"
- 6) A Miny *Microcosm of Roman Society* In Every Detail
- 7) Governed By A Proconsul & Senate Seat After 44 A.D. (Currently 51 A.D. When Visited)
- 8) Greco-Roman Culture & Religion Only No Known Official Jewish Presence / Religion
- 9) Main Greco-Roman School of Medicine Luke Studied Medicine Here & Considered It His "Alma Mater"
- 10) Luke Considered *Philippi* <u>His Chosen Hometown</u> After Moving From *Antioch on the Orontes* <u>His Birth Hometown</u>
