Now it was the Feast of Dedication (Hanukkah) in Jerusalem, and it was winter. And Jesus walked into the Temple, in Solomon's Portico. Then the Jews surrounded Jesus and said to Him, "How long do You keep us in doubt? If You are the Christ, tell us plainly." Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The Works (Signs & Wonders) that I Do In My Father's Name, They (Works) Bear Witness of Me. But you do not believe, because you are not of My Sheep, as I said to you. My Sheep hear My Voice, and I Know Them, and they Follow Me. And I Give Them Eternal Life, and They shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch Them Out Of My Hand. My Father, Who has given Them to Me, Is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch Them Out Of My Father's Hand. I and My Father are One!" Then the Jews took up stones again to stone Him.

Jesus Taught Them, "Hear Now Another Parable: There was a certain landowner who planted a vineyard and set a hedge around it, dug a winepress in it and built a tower. And he leased it to vinedressers and went into a far country. Now when vintage-time drew near, he sent his servants to the vinedressers, that they might receive its fruit. And the vinedressers took his servants, beat one, killed one, and stoned another. Again, he sent other servants, more than the first, and they did likewise to Them. Then last of all he sent his son to Them, saying, 'They will respect my son!' But when the vinedressers saw the son, they said among themselves, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and seize his inheritance.' So, They (Jewish Religious Authorities) took him and cast him out of the vineyard and killed him. "Therefore, when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those vinedressers?" They (Jewish Religious Authorities) said to Him, "He will destroy those wicked men miserably, and lease his vineyard to other vinedressers who will render to him the fruits in their seasons." Jesus said to Them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: 'The Stone which the builders rejected Has Become the Chief Cornerstone. This was the Lord's Doing, and It Is Marvelous (Beautiful) In Our Eyes'? Therefore, I say to you, the Kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a Nation bearing the fruits of it. And Whoever Falls On This Stone Will Be Broken; But On Whomever It Falls, It Will Grind Him To Powder!" Now when the Chief Priests and Pharisees Heard His Parables, they perceived that He Was Speaking of Them (Jewish Religious Authorities). But when They sought to lay hands on Him, They feared the multitudes, because they took *Him for a Prophet*. Matthew 21:33-46 (NKJV)
