
"Witnessing Boldy Brings A Divine Witness Accompanied By Signs & Wonders, Opposition, & Persecution!"

Acts 14:1-7

Now it happened in Iconium that They (Paul & Barnabas) went Together to the Synagogue of the Jews, and so Spoke (Preach & Teach) that <u>a great multitude both of the Jews and of the Greeks</u> Believed. But the Unbelieving Jews stirred up the Gentiles and poisoned their minds against the Brethren. Therefore, They (Paul & Barnabas) Stayed there a Long Time, Speaking Boldly in the Lord, Who <u>was</u> Bearing Witness <u>to the</u> Word of His Grace, Granting Signs and Wonders to be <u>done by</u> Their Hands. But the multitude of the city was divided: part sided with the Jews, and part with the Apostles. And when a violent attempt was made by both the Gentiles and Jews, with their rulers, to abuse and stone Them (Paul & Barnabas), They became aware of it and fled to Lystra and Derbe, cities of Lycaonia, and to the surrounding region. And They were Preaching the Gospel there.

"After Being Persecuted & Threatened Where Do Paul & Barnabas Go Next After Leaving Pisidian Antioch?"

A They Travel To Iconium – Lystra – Derbe Overland Distance From Pisidian Antioch To Iconium Is About 95 Miles Overland Distance From Iconium To Lystra Is About 23 Miles Overland Distance From Lystra To Derbe Is About 78 Miles New Missionary Journeys

Paul Enters The Local Synagogue & Awaits An Opportunity To Preach / Teach / Debate NOTE Paul Always Uses A 4-Part Formula When Sharing The Gospel of Good News 1) OT Kerygma Central Story of Deliverance & Salvation of God's People According To God's Plan & Promise 2) NT Kerygma Central Story of Deliverance & Salvation of God's People Fulfilled In Jesus Christ 3) Support With Various Scriptures Use The Scriptures Read In The Synagogue / Church Meeting That Day &/Or Use Supporting Scriptures From The Bible 4) Exhort & Encourage The Audience To Go Further In Their Thinking & Understanding Of The Past & Their Lives "What Is The Response God Desires Of His True Followers When They Are Personally Prosecuted or Threatened?" "What Is The Response God Desires Of His True Followers When The Gospel Message Is Debated, Defamed, Distorted, Silenced, Or Threatened?" True Believers/Followers Of Jesus Christ Are To Be Bold In His Spirit & Speak Up For The Gospel They Are Always Ready To Follow Through With A 4-Fold Plan: 1) Presentation, 2) Decision, 3) Judgement, & 4) Movement 3) Judgement & 4) Movement But the Jews (Religious Authorities of the Regional Synagogue) stirred up the devout and prominent women and the chief men of the City (Pisidian Antioch), raised up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their region. But They (Paul & Barnabas) shook off the dust from their feet against Them (Jewish Religious Authorities), and came to Iconium.
