Nevertheless, I have a few things against you because you allow that 'Woman Jezebel, ...

... Who Calls Herself a Prophetess', to teach and seduce My Servants to commit sexual immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols". And I gave Her time to repent of her sexual immorality, and She did not repent. Indeed, I will cast Her into a sickbed, and Those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless They repent of their deeds. I will kill Her Children with death, and All the Churches shall know that I AM He Who searches the minds and hearts. And I will give to each One of you according to your works. Now to You I Say (Rhema), and to the Rest in Thyatira, as many as do not have this (False) Doctrine, Who have not known the depths of Satan, as They (Church Leaders & Council) Say, I will put on you no other burden. But hold fast what you have Till I Come (Again). And He Who overcomes, and keeps My Works until the end, to Him I will give power over the nations, 'He shall rule Them with a rod of iron; They shall be dashed to pieces like the potter's vessels', as I also have received from My Father; and I will give Him the Morning Star (My Very Self – My Everlasting Presence). He who has an ear, let Him hear what the Spirit Says (Rhema) to the Churches!"
